ACADEMIC DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES IN THE COLLEGE

1) LMS: Digital Classrooms for the Digital Age. To embrace technology for effective classroom management, enhance learning and teaching with digital means we work in partnership with STMAGZ LMS is an easy-to-customize Learning Management System with many useful features which provides virtual hub (from Web browser and Mobile App) for Staff and Students. www.Stumagz.in.St.Annsmallapur is a digital platform which enables effective teaching and learning, Continuous assessment by conducting unit wise e-tests, e-assignments, e-material tracking student progress, e-attendance, e-notifications and e-reporting are all enabled through this digital platform. Lecturers create and upload the e-content which can be accessed by students anytime, anywhere from devices like smart phones, tablets, lap-tops and desk top computers..

2) Courses:

Besides providing curricular academic knowledge, College also gives a platform for Students to enrol themselves in various courses.

a) Bridge courses

Bridge courses are preparative courses designed to fill the gap of student's level with an academic curriculum that is offered to enhance the knowledge of the students from previous course. Some of the courses offered for UG and PG students in 1 semester were on subjects "Basics of Financial Accounting" and "Fundamentals of Computers".

b) Remedial Classes (Taarana) are conducted for slow learners to assist them to cope up with pace of the curriculum.Remedial classes are organized in every subject on working days after regular class hours, to help students perform well in the exams.

c) Certificate Courses:

College offers standalone courses and certificate programs that can prepare students for professional certification. Online and on-campus certificate programs are offered.
